

Aviation English Instructor (specialised EFL)

The successful applicant will join a team of five instructors based in Bangkok. The position involves:

- Developing tailored aviation-specific English print-based and online curriculum materials.
- Delivering the team's curriculum materials in short lessons and workshops in Bangkok and at regional airports across Thailand to develop language and ATC-pilot communication skills.
