



Aviation English Instructor and Curriculum Writer

The initial contract will be for 12 months and includes a review after a three-month probation period.

The successful applicant will join a team of instructors and curriculum writers based in Bangkok. The position involves:

- Developing aviation English curriculum materials for online delivery.
- Developing and adapting aviation English curriculum materials for class delivery.
- Delivering short lessons and workshops in Bangkok and at regional airports across Thailand to develop language and ATC-pilot communication skills.

The position requires:

- Commitment to the effective and efficient development and implementation of the Aviation English programme at AEROTHAI through active contribution as a member of a small team.
- An ability to meet deadlines and respond effectively to constructive feedback during curriculum reviews
- An ability to work autonomously as a curriculum writer
- An ability to work within a large organisation outside mainstream institutional education settings requiring creative solutions to course scheduling, provision of training where ongoing/intensive training options are limited in the support of professional adults working on tight schedules.
